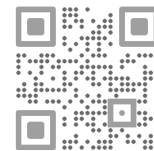

- Implemented continuous integration for core product line and laid groundwork for fully-automated continuous deployment system.

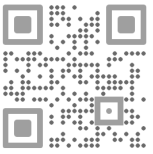
